

David Naugle, Professor, Wildlife Biology Program, University of Montana, Missoula, and Science Advisor, USDA NRCS Sage-grouse Initiative. Dr. Naugle's applied research focuses on creating conservation planning and evaluation tools to promote conservation of mid-continent and western grassland ecosystems. His many published papers have characterized scale-dependent habitat use in birds, assessed effects of wind energy on wildlife, evaluated wildlife benefits of CRP, and probed the sociology behind changing land use practices. His new book evaluates impacts of oil and gas development on sage-grouse populations. As part of this work, Dave and his students were the first to discover and quantify mortality of sage-grouse from West Nile virus.
