

Ron Hanson, Neal E. Harlan Professor of Agribusiness, Department of Agricultural Economics, University of Nebraska-Lincoln. Professor Hanson's college teaching and student advising career of 39 years has earned 26 university and national recognitions. He has received the John Deere Agribusiness Teaching Award of Excellence and the University Educator of the Year Award. Ron is the only Nebraska professor to have received the USDA Excellence in University Teaching which is the highest national teaching honor granted to a college professor in the area of agricultural and food sciences. His two most distinguished career honors were being named the Nebraska Professor of the Year by the Carnegie Foundation in Washington, DC and being named the Educator of the Year by the University student government. He has counseled with Nebraska farm families for more than 30 years to help them resolve family conflicts in a more positive manner and to improve family relations through better communications. Ron was raised on an Illinois family farm. He earned his undergraduate college degree from Western Illinois University and his graduate degrees from the University of Illinois.
