They are joined on the ranch by their son Chet, his wife Heather and their four young boys. Their ranch is a cow-calf operation with spring calving on the range in February and March and a 90-day winter feeding period from January to April. Clinesmith's raise alfalfa irrigated from Cow Creek for their winter feed. The cow herd is a Hereford base with Red & Black Angus bulls used over the years. They run about 30 acres to a cow. The Clinesmith's also provide recreation to a Hunt & Fish Club year around and pen raise pheasants, quail & chukars. Mule deer, geese, ducks and rainbow trout are in abundance on the ranch. Roy and Chet Clinesmith are Life Members of SRM and enjoy the summer tours in Canada and nearby.
